Rafal was great at making the classroom feel safe and any feedback he provided for sure only enabled me to be a better student and Director.

When I was finally doing the in-studio scenes for the course, I was extremely nervous because it was my first experience dealing with actors, a production crew, but also having the professors and students observing me in real time and yet I never once felt like a failure or that I wasn't capable of rising above a challenge. Rafal's feedback were real and honest, and it allowed me to listen and see an outsider's perspective of the scene that I am capturing. In many ways I felt that Rafal finally gave me the permission to truly be a director and take charge of the scene and the actors. In return it allowed me to capture a great performance and a very beautiful and organic experience with the actors. It is an experience that I will never forget and always cherish, and the fact that he allowed me to do the in-studio scene more than one, gave me the sense of pride and honor that he believed in my gifts and truly wants me to succeed.

That is an experience that I will never take for granted and I am grateful to have been his student and UM is extremely lucky to have Rafal as a professor teaching the next generation of filmmakers.
